- 1. Read Proverbs 5:3-6. Where does the path of the immoral woman lead?
- 2. Proverbs 7:21-27 describes a promiscuous woman who uses her words to flatter and flirt. What does that behavior lead to? What are some reasons women may flirt? Take a moment to examine your heart and recognize if you are flirtatious with men.
- 3. Who does Ephesians 5:1-2 say we are to imitate? Why? Read verses 3-4 about a pure lifestyle. How would this benefit your sexual purity and marriage?
- 4. How does Proverbs 12:4 contrast a noble wife to a disgraceful wife? What are some ways that we can build a strong character that blesses and benefits those around us? List the Godly traits found in Galatians 5:22-23.
- 5. Marriage requires much time, effort, patience and wisdom. How does 1 Peter 3:3-9 instruct us to live? How are you doing?

Godly wisdom will protect our sexual purity and build strong healthy marriages. Love and respect for each other can be an example of God's love in us to others. Let's not point fingers at each other, but strive to be the Godly wife that He calls us to be! We are called to be a blessing.
